



Haitian Led - Haitian Run - Lifesaving Programs that Last!

Medical humanitarians are currently debating a question we at Hands Up for Haiti began asking several years ago: is sending visiting medical missions to deliver outreach care for short periods really the most effective way to provide health care to the developing world?

After careful thought and discussions with our Haitian medical colleagues and staff, our answer to this question is "NO". Rather, **Haitian Led - Haitian Run** is the way to make a lasting impact and ensure a permanent legacy of sustainable programs.

Several years ago, we initiated the change: rather than focusing on sending teams in the hope that the team can deliver care to the maximum number of patients, HUFH is focused on delivering support to our Haitian medical staff and providing them with education, equipment and funding so that our staff on the ground can provide care year round rather than waiting for medical teams to show up. Our volunteer teams now provide targeted support to programs such as malnutrition and hypertension. Our Global Health Education teams still bring young doctors and nurses to work and to learn about how to deliver health care in a developing country such as Haiti. While there, they work side by side with our Haitian staff and can assist our team on the ground provide wider outreach for children several times a year, teaching and learning at the same time.

We are proud that our Haitian staff, who know best the needs of the communities we serve and how best to deliver that care, is leading the way.

Fritznel Jean, Hands Up for Haiti's Assistant In-Country Executor, sums it up:

"Together with your support, we made Hands Up for Haiti become our own on the ground and that brought many positive changes. At Hands Up for Haiti, because we have done so much EDUCATION and TRAINING, our ground staff takes over. Our Hands up for Haiti staff does not give up. The problem: Hands Up for Haiti works in extremely impoverished communities without dependable electricity or adequate sanitation. The average family exists on less than \$2 each day and lacks access to basic medical care.

HUFH's solution: Our HUFH-trained community health workers go into the homes of their neighbors, making sure that those in need of care get it. And our in-country team of Haitian doctors and nurses hold low-cost clinics in these communities on a regular basis, treating hundreds of patients, primarily children, monthly. No one is turned away.







Help us continue our Haitian run programs. \$60 pays for a Haitian doctor for one day; \$30 for a Haitian nurse; \$80 for a Haitian community health worker for an entire month.
